

GHS HAZARD PICTOGRAMS

UNDERSTAND THE CHEMICAL LABEL

Use this quick guide to recognise common chemical hazards. Always check the full label and current SDS.



1. Explosive

May explode if heated, shocked or mishandled.



2. Flammable

Can catch fire easily. Keep away from heat, sparks and flames.



3. Oxidising

May intensify fire or react strongly with other materials.



4. Gas under pressure

Container may burst if heated. Handle and store carefully.



5. Corrosive

Can burn skin and eyes and damage metals.



6. Acute toxicity

Toxic or fatal if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed.



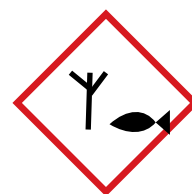
7. Irritant / harmful

May irritate skin, eyes or airways, or cause other harmful effects.



8. Health hazard

May cause serious long-term health effects such as respiratory sensitisation or organ damage.



9. Environmental hazard

May harm aquatic life. Prevent release to the environment.
